
Entry Requirements (Work experience and grade tariffs)

Veterinary Sciences/ Medicine (5 Years)





Pathways into Vet Nursing

Veterinary Nursing

Higher Education

- Year 0 Courses available
- Entry tariff lower than Vet Med
- Academically-focused
- Structured approach to learning and work experience
- Gives you the opportunity to study a postgraduate degree and specialise

Apprenticeship

- GCSE Requirements and Work experience
- Usually done alongside employment in a veterinary practice
- Employers often fund your studies

Level 3 Course

- Level 3 diploma at college
- GCSE Requirements
- More practical and placement based
- Takes 2 years to complete
- Can 'top up' to a degree later on if you choose to specialise
